
### Sharing A Meal Together

Although the responsibility toward those preparing for Confirmation is with the whole parish, it is difficult for a large group to minister personally to each candidate. That's why your role as sponsor is important, you are the **personal** representative of the church for the candidate.

### Sponsors Are Companions


Being a sponsor means that you serve as a companion or guide. You are asked to walk with the candidate on his/her faith journey. From the beginning, be open to the realization that this process can be just as much of a journey for yourself as it is for the one you sponsor. Welcome this opportunity as an occasion to renew your own faith life. Your own openness to spiritual growth will help the person you sponsor be more open to growing in the faith.

## A companion needs to be available.

Assure your candidate of your willingness to help whenever you are needed. Most of the time the need is to offer support when there is hesitation, understanding when there is doubt, or comfort when there is inner conflict. Occasionally the candidate may need to be challenged by you when his or her effort or enthusiasm weakens.
