

Dear 7th and 8th grade parents:

As part of their Confirmation formation, each student is expected to perform at least **35 hours** of Community service. Seventh (7th) graders will complete a maximum of **15 hours** for next year's Confirmation. They will complete another **20 hours or more** (if required) during their eighth (8th) grade year as an extension of their full initiation into the Catholic Church through Confirmation.

Since the total required is 35 hours, if 15 hours are not completed in 7th grade, the difference must be made up during 8th grade. However, any hours in excess of 15 hours in 7th grade cannot be carried over to 8th grade.

A maximum of 5 hours is allowed per activity per school year. This results in a minimum of 3 activities in 7th grade and 4 activities in 8th grade. Activities are not allowed to be personal/familial activities. For example, no free babysitting or grass cutting. All activities must be performed at either the parish or in the community. Some examples include soup kitchens, the humane society, and nursing homes. A "school year" for 7th grade is considered September 1st through May 31st.

A "school year" for 8th grade is considered June 1st through March 31st.

Including the summer between 7th and 8th grade year will allow the student to accrue hours for activities that may not usually be accessible in the fall and spring.

A form is to be signed at the completion of each activity indicating the date, a description of the activity, the number of hours completed, and signed by a person in charge of the activity. Many students will complete more than 35 hours of service and that is a wonderful testament to their Faith. Your encouragement and involvement with this process will serve as a prime motivator for them.

Remember...Confirmation and service hours are not the end of PSR, but the beginning of being a fully initiated member in the Church sharing their life and faith with all.
